

Join Us for the Jamaica Plain Lantern Parade!!



When: Saturday Evening, October 18th, 2014

Where: The parade takes place on the gravel path around Jamaica Pond (located near Pond Street in Jamaica Plain. There is parking on side streets and behind the pond near the Brookline Track.)

Public Transportation:

MBTA Orange Line (Green Street stop, about 12 minute walk) or 39 Bus (stop at Center and Pond Street)

Where to meet:

-Jamaica Pond Boathouse at 6:00 pm. Ms. Aliberti, Ms. Crable (B3 art teacher) and Ms. Lockwood (B1 art teacher) will be at the boathouse (across from the intersection of Pond Street and the Jamaicaway to meet families. **Look for Brooke signs!**

We will begin our walk around the pond at 6:15 SHARP!

**** IMPORTANT: All students MUST be accompanied by a parent/guardian at all times during this event. Teachers will not be responsible for supervising students. All family members are welcome!**

What to Bring:

-Bring your lantern! We will provide battery powered tea-lights. You can also light your lantern with a small flashlight or candle from home if you want.

-Dress for the weather – it will probably be very cold. (Some people like to wear Halloween costumes to this parade, though it is not a Halloween parade.)

- The path around the pond is 1 ½ miles long; please be sure to wear comfortable shoes.

-There is some food and drink available at the parade, bring some money for snacks.

RAIN DATE: If it is raining, we will meet instead on Sunday, 10/19 for the second night of the parade (locations and times will be the same.)

Students will be completing their lanterns this week in art.
